

For the teams that would like to use the proximity of Poland we can organize also the trip to the historical town of Krakow (cca 180 km) or the visit of the death camp of Auschwitz.

New Vitkovice that considers revitalization of so-called Bottom Vitkovice, which is an industrial area with National Cultural Monument of Blast Furnaces




Beskydy Mountains
