

# How to reach us

## Setting GPS: Rue Copernic (Béthune) for buses only


### *Coming from the toll*




- At the exit of toll take "other directions" at **Right**
- Take the roundabout **Left** towards Lille / Arras / Lens
- Straight until the <sup>2nd</sup> roundabout and take **Left** "Béthune center"
- After Citroën take bias **Left**
- Take <sup>1st</sup> Left then immediately **Right**


# Coming from Lille



- Stay on the fast track for 4 roundabouts
- The 5<sup>th</sup> roundabout "Bethune center" **Right**
- After Citroën take bias **Left**
- Take 1<sup>st</sup> Left then immediately **Right**




# Coming in Lillers



- At the large roundabout (St Pry) **go** straight towards the railway stations
- After Station take **Left** (Ave Lens)
- At the roundabout turn **Right** towards Arras / Lens / Noeux les Mines
- **WARNING:** Immediately to the descent of the bridge turn **Right 2 times**
- Take the <sup>1st</sup> to **Left and Right**



## Coming from Hazebrouck



- At the “Anne d’Artois “ take Béthune center.
- Stay on this main axis until the Lycée Blaringhem
- Turn **Right** at the roundabout
- Take bias **Left** at the roundabout towards Arras / Noeux les Mines
- **Go Face** at the roundabout towards Arras / Noeux the Mines
- **WARNING:** Immediately to the descent of the bridge turn **Right 2 times**
- Take the <sup>1st</sup> to **Left** then **Right**.

# Rules of Tournament

1. Regulation by “Rugby Digest”
  2. A team is considered complete by having the required number of players per category plus 2 alternates.
  3. In case of injury of several players if a team comes to be incomplete effective, the opposing team must align.
  4. A team declared incomplete in the morning can play, but lose its matches which will be marked with a deficit of 3 trials.
  5. Any late field team starts off with a deficit of 2 trials.
  6. In case of delay during the tournament, the organizers reserve the right to change the announced game time.
  7. In case of equality in the pool matches the difference will be on:
    - Exclusion in 1st place
    - the total number of scored tries
    - the total number of collected tries
    - a coin
  8. In case of equality on the final games, there is no extension. The victory is awarded based on:
    - exclusions in 1st place
    - the team that scores first
    - goal average of the previous game.
    - goal average of morning matches
  9. All match results are signed by the captain.
  10. No claim may be made after signature.
  11. All referees are volunteers and enthusiasts. As a result, problems result in a penalty of one point decided by the head of the field.
  12. In case of big problem (deterioration of materials, misconduct of a player, evil spirit of an educator, etc.), the organization reserves the right to exclude the team or the club tournament.
- The friendly atmosphere of the tournament must be preserved.*
13. Only a responsible team is empowered to come to the scorer's table  
(No player child will get information).

## ***1 / THE CHALLENGE OF FAIR PLAY.***

The Challenge rewards the club with the most votes from the other delegations

## ***2 / THE CHALLENGE DAVID LOUAFI (FORMER CADET DIES PREMATURELY)***

This Challenge rewards the most offensive team will score the most tries during the Sunday morning group matches.

- In case of equality, will be considered the final testing phases.
- In case of equality of the second row, will be considered the general goal average of the team.

## ***3/ THE TROPHY CATEGORY (THE FRANK REMOND TROPHY).***

In each category, a classification is made from first to last representative.

## ***4 / CLUB TROPHY (CHALLENGE J. DUCASSE).***

This challenge rewards the most complete club.

It is awarded based on specific criteria (see table below) by obtaining points.

Involvement in different categories	10 pts
Final categorization for the first 5	50, 40, 30, 20, 10 pts
Fair Play: vote of the tournament organizing team (*)	20 pts

(\*) This vote concerns the attitude of educators and players off the field (compliance with local, respect for volunteers, management of children by educators, courtesy, friendliness, etc.)




## General view of the establishment in the city
